NORTH WEST NORFOLK WEEK SAILING INSTRUCTIONS 2017

These sailing instructions should be read in conjunction with the N.W.N.S.A. General Instructions.

1. **START TIMES.** The start times and High Water times are as listed in the Event Programme.
2. **STARTING LINE:** Between a bladder buoy with an orange flag and the committee boat central mast, near the leeward mark outside the course.
3. **COURSES:** The standard course shall be a triangle, rounding to port, with the start / finish situated as in 2.
4. **STARTING SIGNALS:** in accordance with rule 26 BUT with 3 min intervals and 30.1 I flag rule (round the ends).
5. **RECALLS:** Rules 29.1 & 29.2 will apply.
6. **FINISH LINE:** Between the leeward mark and the committee boats central mast.
7. **MARKS OF COURSE:** Orange bladder buoys.
6. **SHORTENED COURSE:** The race shall be approximately 60 minutes duration with no fixed number of laps. At this time flag 'S' shall be raised when the leading boat rounds the wing mark.
9. **TIME LIMIT:** To be classed as a finisher all competitors must complete the course within 15 minutes of their leading class boat.
10. **PENALTIES:** The 720-deg turns penalty of rule 44 and the 360-deg turns stated in rule 31.2 shall apply.
11. **RETIREMENTS:** Any crews retiring must sign the retirement declaration immediately on returning to the club house.
12. **PROTESTS:** In accordance with Rule 61.3 to the Race Officer with a fee of £10. Protests must be lodged within half hour of the last boat to finish the last race.
13. **SAFETY:** A tally system may be used in addition to the signing ON / OFF declaration in the General Instructions.
