Wells Sailing club - NWNSA Meeting Local Sailing Instructions

These Sailing Instructions are supplemental to the overall NWNSA General Sailing Instructions and cover local information specific to Wells Sailing Club.

1. Start Times & Class Flags & Order of Starts

The sequence of races for all four classes will be as per the NWNSA General Instructions:

1. National 12 - Letter T

2. Allcomers Fleet - Numeral Pennant 1.

The start time for the first race is 0700 followed by other classes at 3-minute intervals.

2. The Course

Courses will be set within Wells harbour depending on the wind direction and conditions.

The course will be displayed on the committee boat 'Natalie Gail'.

Wells SC has permanent large yellow can buoys which can be supplemented with yellow

pillar buoys when needed. A course map is attached.

Please allow 30 minutes to reach the race area.

The club will endeavour to tow boats through the quay if necessary, but this is subject to available resource and not guaranteed.

3. The Start

The start will be between the mast of committee boat 'Natalie Gail' and a yellow buoy.

4. The Finish

The finishing line will be between a mark of the course and the committee boat (or other boat) flying a blue flag.

5. Time limits

No boat will be allowed to start more than 2 minutes after their race start. If the first boat does not complete the course within 2 hours the race shall be abandoned.

Boats failing to finish within 20 minutes of the leading boat shall be scored RET.
